



In tax year 2008, NH residents received \$115 million federal EITC dollars. Internal Revenue Service estimates show that nationally between 75% and 80% of eligible individuals claim the Earned Income Tax Credit. It is estimated that between \$28 million and \$38 million EITC dollars were unclaimed by NH residents for tax year 2008.
